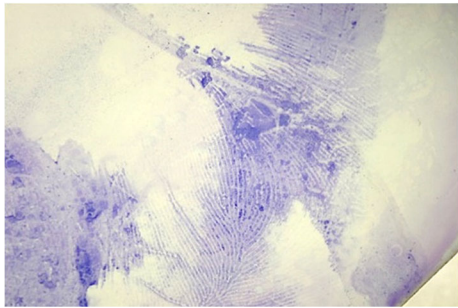

Developing Bloody Prints

Take the next step in fingerprint processing. In this course, you will develop fingerprints using a variety of chemicals and

alternative light sources. The second half of this class focuses on developing bloody fingerprints. Not all chemicals are equal. You will document which chemicals you found to be useful and others that can stay in the closet. This is a hands-on training course.

Class Size Limit: 20 students

Dr. Michael McCutcheon is a full-time police officer and college professor. As a 19-year police veteran, he worked as a patrolman, detective, detective sergeant, and patrol sergeant. He has taught at the collegiate level since 2007 and is currently a criminal justice professor at Southern New Hampshire University.
