Photography Techniques

This workshop is designed to supply the student with the knowledge to utilize their camera in various working situations that they may encounter at crime scenes.

The following topics will be covered:

- basic review of the camera using Aperture Priority, Manual and Program Mode
- applying *Painting with Lighting* techniques to photograph laser trajectories used during Shooting Reconstruction
- using Direct and Axial Lighting to produce exam quality latent print images
- using tripods and inclinometers for exam quality footwear and tire track images
- photographing body fluids treated with *Bluestar* or using an ALS

The attendees will be given demonstrations and practical exercises in reference to the above topics.

Instructors

Mark Zabinski, B.S.-is presently employed as a Criminalist II, Latent Print Examiner for the Rhode Island State Crime Laboratory for the past 14 years. He has 12 years of prior crime scene investigation experience with the Cranston Police Department. Mark is also a professional photographer and has been teaching photography classes to crime scene investigators for the past 26 years, including digital enhancement. Mark is certified by the IAI as a Senior Crime Scene Analyst and Certified Latent Print Examiner.

Dr. Mike McCutcheon-is a Patrol Sergeant in Londonderry, NH. Mike has been working at the Londonderry Police Department since 2000. He began as a patrolman and served in that position for 4 years. In 2004 Mike was promoted to Detective. He worked as a detective for 3 years until he was promoted to Sergeant in 2007.

Mike is the owner of Forensic Education, LLC a hands-on training company for law enforcement and he is a criminal justice professor at Southern New Hampshire University and Rivier University. Mike is a crime scene consultant and instructor for the *Lynn Peavey Company* and *Laura Pettler and Associates*. Mike is also a Vice President for the New England Division of the IAI.
